other extra cost + allowance for children, if the case)

**Duration:** max. 2 years

**Aimed at:** Female artists from the following departments: Orchestra

**Awarding criteria:** The goal is a qualification for professorship

**Committee:** Specialist jury

tabular form incl. description of artistic career, artistic work: recordings or other documentation of the of the artist's work (no originals needed!); certificate of final recital (in case this has not yet happened, a grade from the teachers is enough) or of other distinctive artistic achievements; description of the artistic project (max. 2 pages); letter of acceptance for the artistic supervision by a full-time teacher/professor from the HMTMH including a statement about the suitability of the artistic project for a further qualification; reference letter from a further teacher,

who is employed by another university
