Provider:	The funds come 50% from the federal government and 50% from private sponsors.
Amount:	300 Euro per month
Duration:	One year, new application is possible
Aimed at:	Students from first and higher semester
Awarding criteria:	Talent with additional consideration of attainments at school and study, societal commitment and special personal attainments, as well as special personal situations
Committee:	Specialist jury
Application period:	17 June - 04 November 2019, support starting from October 2019 retrospectively
Commitments:	None
Application requirements:	Application form (see download), Please note: You will find different application forms for students applying in their first semester and those applying in higher semesters!

› Scholarship “Start your Studies”

Provider:	Scholarships are financed from the foundation as well as from donations with precise aims.
Amount:	750 Euros per Semester
Duration:	up to a maximum of 2 semesters
Aimed at:	Students of the Bachelor-, Master- and the Diploma Programme Acting, who are in the 1 st or 2 nd semester
Awarding criteria:	Anticipation of positive achievements in the course of studies; financial needs
Selection procedure:	Interview with two board members of the foundation and four members from the teaching staff of HMTMH in December 2019 at the HMTMH
Application period:	01 October - 11 November 2019
Commitments:	Engagement in the University and/or in the society and your participation in the annual fellow concert
Application requirements:	Application, report form and financial form (see download), CV in tabular form with photo, motivation letter (max. 1 A4-page) with personal details, professional aims, and about financial situation. Details about current scholarships

› Scholarship for advanced students

Provider:	This scholarship is financed through a Gala Concert “Musik braucht Freunde” in collaboration with the “Förderkreis” of the HMTMH.
Amount:	750 Euros per semester
Duration:	Max. 2 semesters, it is possible to apply again for the scholarship
Aimed at:	Students of the Bachelor-, Master- and the Diploma Programme Acting who are in the 3 rd semester or higher
Awarding criteria:	Necessity
Selection procedure:	Interview with a specialist committee in November 2019 at the HMTMH
Application period:	01 October - 11 November 2019
Commitments:	The scholarship holders can be asked to participate in the annual Gala concert “Musik braucht Freunde”.
Application requirements:	Application form, financial form and expert review (see download), CV in tabular form with photo, motivation letter including personal details as well as career goals and financial situation within the study period (max. 1 page A4). Details about current scholarships

› Scholarship of the Hannover Region

Provider:	Hannover Region. 6 students can be supported.
Amount:	650 Euros per semester
Duration:	2 semesters
Aimed at:	Students from Voice and KA, KPA, FÜBA programmes of study with emphasis on Woodwind, Brass, Percussion, Strings, Accordion, Guitar
Awarding criteria:	High artistic achievement. Socially disadvantaged, international students have priority.
Committee:	Jury made out of lecturers of the HMTMH under the chairmanship of Prof. Johannes Peitz-Tiemann
Application period:	in May 2020 Support starts from winter semester 2020/21
Commitments:	The Scholarship holders commit themselves to offer musical entertainment, forming an ensemble, in max. 8 ceremonious events per semester in the Hannover Region (especially German citizenship awarding ceremony).
Application requirements:	Application form (to download), autonomous forming of ensembles, preparing pieces for the concerts and learning the German national anthem (to accompany singing)

› Gundlach Music Prize

Provider:	Gundlach Foundation. 4 students get awarded for 2 years each.
Amount:	300 Euros per month as well as a free apartment as well as practising possibilities at the “Vielharmonie”, Rumannstraße 9. The monetary value of this scholarship is about 20.000 Euro.
Duration:	4 semesters
Aimed at:	Students from the following departments: instrumental, singing, composition and musicology (in their advanced stages of study). During the period of the scholarship it is undesired that the scholarship holder takes a semester on leave.
Awarding criteria:	High artistic achievements, personal situation (family, finances) and societal commitment
Committee:	Independent specialist jury
Application period:	January - April 2021 Support starts in winter semester 2021/22
Commitments:	Concerts in the HMTMH and in the “Vielharmonie“, for example the yearly Serenade concert
Application requirements:	personal letter, application form (to download), CV in tabular form with photo written in German, reference from the principal study teacher (to download)

› Scholarships of the Music and Gender Research Centre of the HMTMH

Provider:	Mariann Steegmann Foundation. 1 full scholarship and 1 partial scholarship per year
Amount:	Full scholarships: 1.000 Euros per month Partial scholarship: 500 Euros per month
Duration:	At first in each case 12 months (with the option of a renewal for a further year), initial funding in each case 6 months
Aimed at:	PhD and Post-Doc students in the field of Gender research topics
Awarding criteria:	Scientific quality of the project
Committee:	Academic board of the Music and Gender Research Centre
Application Deadline:	31. January 2020
Commitments:	None
Application requirements:	Project description (7-10 pages), CV, if possible, a list of existing publications (all on paper and on CD-ROM)

› Scholarships of the Dorothea-Erxleben-Programme of the HMTMH for female artists

Provider:	50% of the funds are received from the Ministry of Science and Culture and 50% from the HMTMH.
Amount:	Full scholarship of 1.750 Euros per month (+ 250 Euros travel and other extra cost + allowance for children, if the case). With the acceptance of the scholarship, the scholarship holder is willing to teach at the University within the extent of 2 weekly lecture hours which will be paid separately.
Duration:	Max. 2 years
Aimed at:	Female artists. Further information will be provided at the following website: www.gsb.hmtm-hannover.de
Awarding criteria:	The goal is a qualification for professorship
Committee:	Specialist jury
Application period:	The next award will be given in the study year 2021.
Commitments:	Within two years after the completion of the scholarship the artistic development needs to be presented in form of a concert, or in an equivalent form.
Application requirements:	One pdf-document: CV in tabular form incl. description of artistic career, artistic work: recordings or other documentation of the artist's work (please provide internet links if possible); certificate of concert diploma and final recital (in case this has not yet happened, a grading from the teachers is enough) or of other distinctive artistic achievements; description of the artistic project (max. 2 pages); reference letter from a further professor/teacher, who is employed by another university
