# Deutschlandstipendien



<b>Provider:</b>	The funds come 50% from the federal government and 50% from private sponsors.
<b>Amount:</b>	300 Euro per month
<b>Duration:</b>	One year, reapplication is possible
<b>Aimed at:</b>	Students from first and higher semester
<b>Awarding criteria:</b>	Talent with additional consideration of attainments at school and study, societal commitment and special personal attainments, as well as special personal situations
<b>Committee:</b>	Specialist jury
<b>Application period:</b>	From around Mid-June 2023 the procedure for 2022/23 is completed
<b>Commitments:</b>	None
<b>Application requirements:</b>	Application form (see download)

# Scholarship “Start your Studies”

<b>Provider:</b>	Scholarships are financed from the foundation’s own funds as well as from donations with precise aims
<b>Amount:</b>	1.000 Euros per semester
<b>Duration:</b>	Depending on the decision of the selection jury for one or a maximum of two semesters
<b>Aimed at:</b>	Students of the Bachelor-, Master- and the Diploma Programme Acting, who are in the 1 <sup>st</sup> or 2 <sup>nd</sup> semester
<b>Awarding criteria:</b>	Anticipation of positive achievements in the course of studies; financial need
<b>Selection procedure:</b>	Interview with two board members of the foundation and four members of the HMTMH teaching staff in December 2022 at the HMTMH
<b>Application period:</b>	4 October - 18 November 2022
<b>Commitments:</b>	Engagement in the University and/or in society and your participation in the annual fellow concert
<b>Application requirements:</b>	Application, report form and financial form (see download), CV in tabular form, portrait photo in digital form, motivation letter (max. 1 A4-page) with personal details, professional aims, and about financial situation. Details about current scholarships

# Scholarship for advanced students

<b>Provider:</b>	This scholarship is financed through a Gala Concert “Musik braucht Freunde” in collaboration with the “Förderkreis” of the HMTMH
<b>Amount:</b>	<b>1.000</b> Euros per semester
<b>Duration:</b>	Depending on the decision of the selection jury for one or a maximum of two semesters It is possible to apply again for the scholarship
<b>Aimed at:</b>	Students of the Bachelor-, Master- and the Diploma Programme Acting who are in the 3 <sup>rd</sup> semester or higher
<b>Awarding criteria:</b>	financial need
<b>Selection procedure:</b>	Interview with a specialist committee from HMTMH in December 2022
<b>Application period:</b>	4 October - 18 November 2022
<b>Commitments:</b>	The scholarship holders can be asked to participate in the annual Gala concert “Musik braucht Freunde”
<b>Application requirements:</b>	Application form, financial form and expert review (see download), CV in tabular form, digital photo in portrait format, motivation letter including personal details as well as career goals and financial situation within the study period (max. 1 page A4). Details about current scholarships

# Scholarship of the Hannover Region

<b>Provider:</b>	Hannover Region; 6 students receive funding
<b>Amount:</b>	650 Euros per semester
<b>Duration:</b>	2 semesters
<b>Aimed at:</b>	Students from Voice and KA, KPA, FÜBA programmes of study with emphasis on Woodwind, Brass, Percussion, Strings, Accordion, Guitar
<b>Awarding criteria:</b>	High artistic achievement, socially disadvantaged, international students have priority
<b>Committee:</b>	Jury made out of lecturers of the HMTMH under the chairmanship of Prof. Johannes Peitz-Tiemann
<b>Application period:</b>	Is still undetermined
<b>Commitments:</b>	The scholarship holders commit themselves to offer small musical concerts with an ensemble in several ceremonious events in the Hannover Region (especially German citizenship awarding ceremony)
<b>Application requirements:</b>	Application form (to download), independent formation of ensembles, preparing pieces for the concerts and learning the German national anthem (to accompany singing)

# Gundlach Music Prize

<b>Provider:</b>	Gundlach Foundation; 4 students get awarded
<b>Amount:</b>	300 Euros per month as well as a free apartment and practice opportunities at the “Vielharmonie”, Rumannstraße 9. The monetary value of this scholarship is about 24.000 Euro
<b>Duration:</b>	4 semesters
<b>Aimed at:</b>	Students of the following departments: instrumental, singing, composition and musicology (in their advanced stages of study). No semester of leave is desired during the cholarship periods
<b>Awarding criteria:</b>	High artistic achievements, personal situation (family, finances) and societal commitment
<b>Committee:</b>	Independent specialist jury
<b>Application period:</b>	January - April 2023 Support starts in winter semester 2023/24
<b>Commitments:</b>	Concerts in the HMTMH and in the “Vielharmonie“, for example the yearly Serenade concert
<b>Application requirements:</b>	Personal letter, application form (to download), CV in tabular form with photo written in German, reference from the principal study teacher (to download)

# Scholarships of the Dorothea-Erxleben-Programme of the HMTMH for female artists

<b>Provider:</b>	50% of the funds are received from the Ministry of Science and Culture and 50% from the HMTMH
<b>Amount:</b>	Full scholarship of 1.750 Euros / month (+ 250 Euros travel and material cost + child allowance, if applicable). With acceptance of the scholarship, the scholarship holder is willing to teach at the University within the extent of 2 weekly lecture hours which will be paid separately
<b>Duration:</b>	2 years max
<b>Aimed at:</b>	Female artists; further information will be provided at the following website: <a href="http://www.gsb.hmtm-hannover.de">www.gsb.hmtm-hannover.de</a>
<b>Awarding criteria:</b>	The goal is a qualification for professorship
<b>Committee:</b>	Specialist jury
<b>Application period:</b>	expected in spring 2023
<b>Commitments:</b>	At the end of the scholarship or within the following two years at the latest, the artistic development needs to be presented in a concert or in another equivalent form
<b>Application requirements:</b>	One pdf-document: CV in tabular form incl. description of artistic career, artistic work: recordings or other documentation of the artist's work (please provide internet links if possible); certificate of concert diploma and final recital (in case this has not yet happened, a grading from the teachers is enough) or of other distinctive artistic achievements; description of the artistic project (max. 2 pages); reference letter from a university teacher, who does not belong to the HMTMH

<b>Important dates/Deadlines:</b>	New call for application expected in Mid-May 2023 for funding for summer semester 2023  Next call for the winter term in November 2023
<b>Commitments:</b>	None
<b>Application requirements:</b>	Bank account statements from the last 3 months, matriculation certificate, written description of the financial situation, copy of the passport/visa and work permit, CV
